KIDSKARE RULES

Only the parent that signs the child in is allowed to pick up the child. We will not allow the child to leave with anyone else, unless we have written permission.

Children must be signed up prior to coming to KidsKare.

There is a 10 minute cry rule. This means if a child cannot be consoled in any manner for at least 10 minutes, the KidsKare staff will get the parent.

Children that are continuously disruptive may lose the privilege of using KidsKare. We will try to work out a solution with the parent, in the hopes that this would never happen.

KidsKare staff has the final say on any decisions regarding a child being asked to leave or any other discrepancies that may occur.

Children may bring in a toy from home, but they will be expected to share the toy with the other children. If the toy is creating a problem, it will be put away and given to the parent when picking up the child. This is to spare any hurt feelings.

SICK POLICY

Health

KidsKare operates for well children only. If a child becomes ill while in KidsKare a KidsKare staff member will notify the parent to come and get their child. If a KidsKare staff member feels that a child is too ill to attend, the KidsKare staff member has the right to refuse entry.

KidsKare will not serve children with:

- A fever of 100.8 degrees or above and/or suspected fever (flushed or warm appearance)
- An unidentified rash
- Severe diaper rash
- Evidence of pink eye, redness of the eye, swollen lids,
- continuous yellow (crusty discharge from the eye)
- Persistent runny nose with moderate non- clear drainage
- Severe coughing
- Rapid or difficulty breathing
- Lethargic behavior associated with one of the other symptoms listed
- Pain of which the child complains and interferes with normal activity
- Diarrhea and/or vomiting
- Evidence of head lice or other parasites
- Sore throat or difficulty swallowing
- Constant bloody nose that is not a result of a blow to the nose

A child may be readmitted to KidsKare:

If visibly free from communicable disease, fever free without benefit of fever reducing medications for 24 hours, and free of vomiting/diarrhea for 24 hours while on a normal diet.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

Children must be signed in and signed out by a staff member. Parents must indicate where in the facility they will be.

NO CALL NO SHOW POLICY

Children signed up for KidsKare that do not show up or parents do not call in to cancel will be charged full amount, 3 dollars for 1st child and 2 dollars for each additional child.

COST

1st child- \$3.00

Each additional child- \$2.00

Unlimited Monthly Use:

- 1 Child/month- \$25.00 (\$5/week or \$1.67/visit)
- 2 Children/month- \$35.00 (\$7.50 week or \$2.50/visit)
- 3 Children/month- \$50.00 (\$11.25/week or \$3.75/visit)
- 4 Children/month- \$65.00 (\$15/ week or \$5/visit)

- \$10 Punch Card
- \$20 Punch Card

SNACKS AND DRINKS

Children are allowed to bring in snacks and drinks from home. We ask that the cups be labeled with the child's name.

Water and snacks are provided during each shift.

We accept donated snacks from the parents. Unfortunately, we cannot accept any snacks with peanuts due to the allergies of some children.

DIAPER/POTTY TRAINING

We request that the children be changed or taken to the restroom prior to coming to KidsKare.

If your child is potty training, we ask that they wear a pull-up. You may want to make sure you have an extra set of clothing, just in case. If your child does have an accident, we may have to come and get you.

If your child is in diapers you must provide them.
