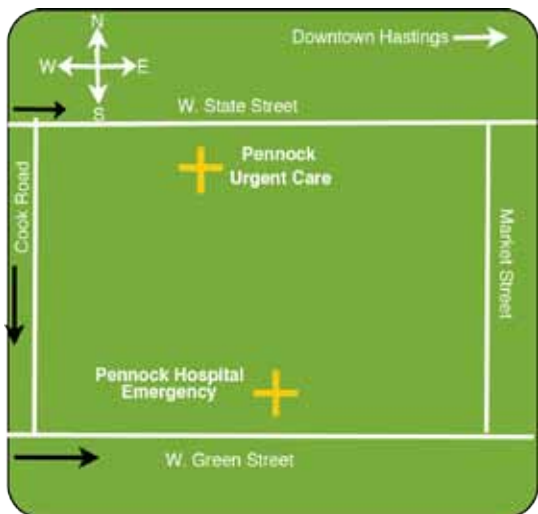


When to use Urgent Care
